### 10. EXPAND SCOPE OF COMMITTEE TO REVIEW SHARED SERVICES

**Discussion:** ECSD is currently providing shared services support to Madison and Knights Landing CSD's. LAFCO has contacted ECSD regarding potential consolidation or providing shared services for Madison, Knights Landing and Cacheville. Madison, Knights Landing and Cacheville CSD's are all interested in exploring potential consolidation or expanded shared services with Esparto CSD.

There are potential funds and incentives available from the State for districts that consolidate.

#### MANAGERS' REPORT

#### A. ECSD Board Election

- a) There will be 3 seats available in November and 3 people submitted applications. There will not need to be an election. The 3 applicants will be appointed.
- b) Applicants who will be appointed:
  - i) Pierce Scott
  - ii) Tracy Prior
  - iii) Adan Sotelo

#### B. Air Conditioner

- a) In August the air conditioner in the ECSD office went out.
- b) GM Quintana contacted numerous A/C companies. Only two were available within a reasonable time frame. Both provided quotes to repair and to replace the entire unit.

- c) Quotes to repair were both approximately \$10,000.
- d) Quotes to replace with a new unit were \$14,500
- e) GM Quintana decided to replace the entire unit and work was completed.

#### C. Pool Update

- a) Season will end at the end of September.
- b) There have been multiple issues with the aquatic center this year including:
  - i) Issues with the controller for the big pool which caused chemicals to stop being dispensed.
  - ii) Autofill valve failed resulting in the pool overfilling, requiring staff to manually monitor and fill.
  - iii) Acid pump failed and stopped dispensing muriatic acid. Parts have been ordered to rebuild the pumps. Staff is currently dosing manually.

#### D. Orciouli Plan Review

- a) GM Quintana and the ECSD Operations Supervisor reviewed the plans for the Orciouli development and provided feedback to the engineer regarding:
  - i) Routing of water and sewer lines in the Southeast corner running under the recreation area. The engineer provided updated plans with lines rerouted.
  - Landscaping around walkways including large trees which could cause root damage to sidewalks, irrigation lines, and possibly water and sewer lines. Currently waiting on response from landscape architect.

- c. GM Quintana will follow up with ECSD staff.
