9. CSDA SPECIAL DISTRICT CHAPTER - YOLO/SOLANO

California Special Districts Association provides information, resources and advocacy for special districts in CA. There are regions and then Chapters within the regions. Chapters are local groups of special districts who collaborate, learn and network based on local needs.

Esparto falls within the Bay Area region. Currently Solano has a small Chapter, Yolo does not. The Solano Chapter has discussed potentially expanding to include Yolo. ECSD's region representative reached out to see if ECSD may be interested in joining. GM Lepley noted that meetings would be quarterly and there could be benefit to local networking.

Board will review and approve a resolution at a future meeting if the chapter does expand to include Yolo.

MANAGERS' REPORT

A. CV Salts Program

- a. GM Lepley along with a representative from City of Davis are co-chairing in initiative to create a management zone within Yolo County.
- b. Luhdorff & Scalmanini will be working to develop the management zone initial action plan. Cost for the engineering study and action plan will be \$204,000 to be split amongst all participating members. Cost allocation has not been fully agreed upon at this time. Proposal for cost sharing is based on nitrate impact. The cost of municipalities is currently looking to be 15% of the total cost, shared amongst the municipalities based on impact. Current estimate for Esparto CSD is \$10,000 for the initial action plan. There will be an annual cost, which is currently unknown.
- Board members are supportive of joining the management zone but also stated that ECSD will
 need to develop a plan for future mitigation.

B. Orciouli Update

- a. Castle Homes has engaged Luhdorrf & Scalmanini for a water system study.
- A meeting was held with SCI Consulting, ECSD and Castle Homes to discuss establishing a Community Facilities District.
- c. Timeline for establishing the CFD was shared with the board. Initial resolution will need to be approved at the September board meeting. A public hearing will need to be held no earlier than 30 days after the initial resolution and no later than 60 days. A Special Meeting will be planned for October 30, 2024 for the public hearing and final resolutions.

C. Tuli Mem

- a. The controller for the wade pool went out. County was notified. New controller was installed August 20, 2024.
- b. Wade pool will remain closed until it has been resurfaced.
