

RESOLUTION NO. 22-01

RESOLUTION CALLING FOR AN ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Esparto Community Services District ("District") did not hold the regular District election in November 2021 for two directors, whose terms were expiring in December 2021; and,

WHEREAS, a quorum exists on the District Board without regard to the two members with expired terms, and one of the two directors continues to occupy her position voluntarily until a successor director qualifies and takes office under the provisions of Government Code section 61042; and,

WHEREAS, the District Board seeks action by the Yolo County Board of Supervisors to call a special election for two full-term directors of the District Board under the provisions of Election Code section 10004, to be consolidated with the June 2022 primary election; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the District requests that the Board of Supervisors call the special election for two full-term director positions of the District Board; and,

BE IT RESOLVED the District requests the Elections Official of the County of Yolo to consolidate said District special election with the June 7, 2022 County primary election; and

BE IT RESOLVED that the candidates for director of the District Board shall pay for the publication of the Candidate's Statement, pursuant to Election Code Section 13307 (a)(1); and that the limitation on the number of words that a candidate may use in his/her/their candidate's statement is 200 words; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Esparto Community Services District agrees to reimburse the Elections Official for costs incurred in conducting the District special election.
